

Research: Educational Technologies Self-Efficacy of Teachers within the Scope of ISTE Standards

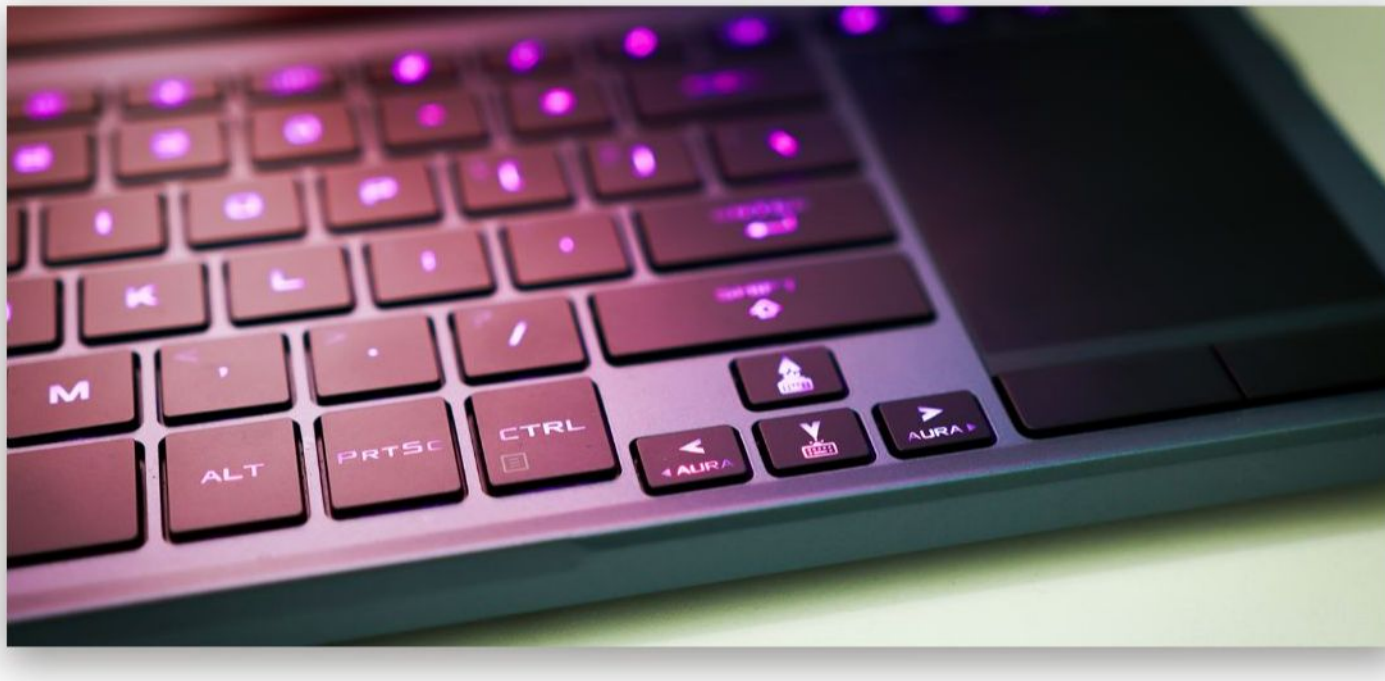

The Place of the Digital World in Literature



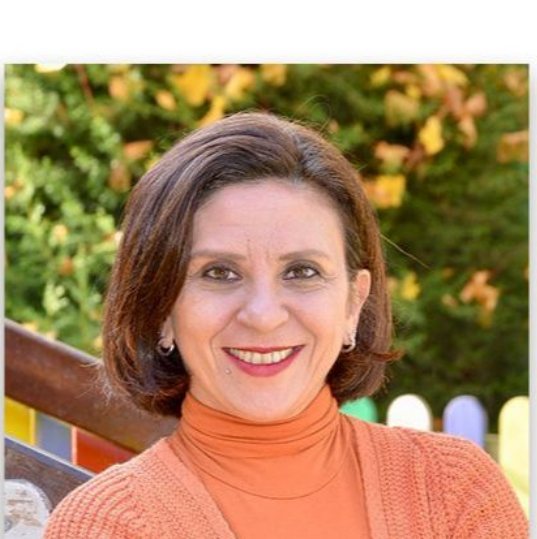

Education for Sustainable Development and STEM



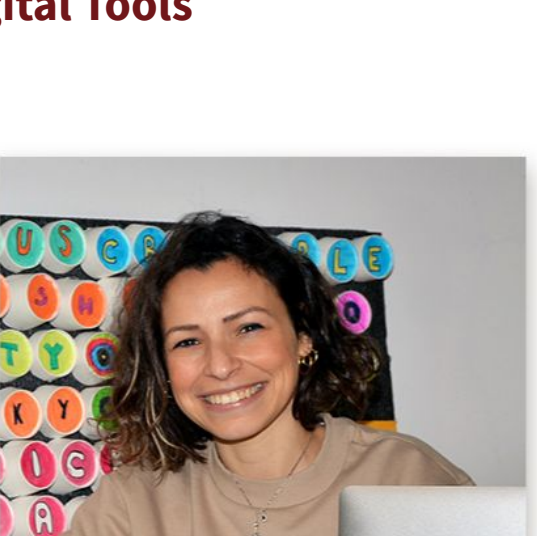
