SCHOOL HISTORY & MISSION

Hisar School, a PreK-12 co-educational day school, was founded in 1996 by Hisar Educational Foundation, a non-profit organization committed to providing an exemplary academic education to the youth of Turkey. Over the brief span of 26 years, Hisar has become one of the leading educational institutions in the country and continues to develop global leaders of the future in Turkey and in the world. Hisar's mission is guiding students to discover and develop their true potential through critical thinking, effective collaboration and meaningful contributions as world citizens with the integration of 21st century skills into the curriculum.

OUR STUDENTS

Hisar School is home to primarily Turkish students who begin in pre-K and transition from our Middle School directly to Grade 9. In addition, a small number of students who excel on a highly competitive national high school entrance exam are admitted each year and may complete an additional year of English Prep depending on their language proficiency. The total pre-K-12 student population is just over 1600 while the high school enrollment is just over 550. Approximately 14% of our students receive merit or need-based scholarships. All graduates matriculate to universities; approximately 85% matriculate overseas.

OUR FACULTY

Hisar School faculty is composed of 81 high school teachers. Of these, 15% are foreign nationals and 66% hold advanced degrees.

ACCREDITATION, INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS & INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERSHIPS

Hisar School is accredited by the Turkish Ministry of Education (MEB), the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) as well as the Council of International Schools (CIS). Hisar School is a Distinguished Apple School, a Common Sense School, and aligns with International Society for Technology in Education (ISTE) Standards. Hisar holds membership in the Turkish Private School Association, Council of International Schools, NACAC, International ACAC, Global School Program, the College Board and the ERB Association.

Hisar School is committed to internationalism in education and aims at developing global citizenship in students.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS & CURRICULUM

All graduates of Hisar School are awarded the Anadolu Lisesi Diploması (Private Anatolian High School Diploma). Students follow a common core curriculum as mandated by the Turkish Ministry of Education (MEB). English is the language of instruction for mathematics, science, English language/literature as well as some electives and all AP courses. Turkish is the language of instruction for some social science courses and Turkish language/literature.

ACADEMIC POLICIES

Hisar School does not report students' class rank. A student's grade point average (GPA) is calculated on the basis of the grade and the number of hours each class meets per week. All courses are included in the cumulative GPA. AP courses are not weighted and are graded on the same scale as other courses. We do not incorporate grades from other institutions in our GPA.

Hisar School's academic program is very rigorous. Students receive numeric grades on a 100 point scale in all courses. The passing grade is 60. In the Class of 2023, the highest GPA was 98.69/100. Hisar students adhere to a strict academic honesty policy, taking responsibility for independent work and learning.

In cases where universities require or request, Hisar School reports all out-of-school suspensions, exclusions, and withdrawals that arise as a result of a disciplinary incident where the incident raises significant concerns about the future safety and well-being of the student concerned or of those with whom she/he interacts; or where the incident raises significant concerns about the academic integrity of the student.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) COURSES

In addition to the rigorous Turkish national curriculum, Hisar offers 24 AP courses to students in Grades 11 and 12. As a result of the course scheduling conflicts with the Turkish Ministry requirements, some of our students not enrolled in the courses study independently and sit for the AP exams. In 2023, 212 Hisar students sat a total of 593 exams in 26 AP subjects. 96% of those who sat for AP exams scored a 3 or above on at least one test.

SPECIAL ACADEMIC PROGRAMS & EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

With the goal of providing an experiential-based learning environment and creating opportunities for students' diverse interests, Hisar has launched several new academic initiatives. While internships and community service have always been an organic part of our culture, students who complete their professional experiences and community service under the School's guidance will have these included on their transcript.

In July 2022 Hisar became the first high school in Turkey to partner with Coursera, the global online learning platform.

Through a department-wide curation process, 300 courses were selected to open to Hisar students through the Coursera for Campus platform. Students may select courses in a wide variety of disciplines as well as areas of personal development and 21st century competencies. When students earn certificates in these courses, it will appear on their transcript as an additional course (Certificate Earned). The goal is that these courses provide independent, flexible, and alternative learning opportunities for students to develop responsibility and gain an international interdisciplinary perspective. If a student completes 50 hours of community service, a ten day internship and two Coursera courses within a one year period, they earn an Extended Learner Certificate. Students work with their respective administrators to meet minimum hour and reflection requirements. In the 2022-2023 school year 47 students in grades 9-11 earned Extended Learner Certificates.

Hisar was recognized as a member of the Global Schools Program in September 2021. An initiative of the Sustainable Development Solutions Network (SDSN) that supports UNESCO's "Global Program of Action on Education for Sustainable Development" (ESD), the mission of the program is to create a world where every student is equipped with the knowledge, values, and skills necessary to effectively respond to this century's greatest challenges and shape a sustainable and prosperous world.

Hisar students actively organize and participate in a wide range of activities and clubs, including the arts, community service, culture, drama, music, sports and STEAM. Students take active roles in THIMUN conferences and have organized an international JMUN conference at Hisar for 16 consecutive years. The Hisar Coding Summit is a virtual and international annual event coordinated by students. In addition to instructing courses, students invite guest speakers from companies such as Google and Microsoft. Student groups participate and place in national and international competitions such as GameJam, FIRST Robotics, Shell Eco-Marathon, as well as hackathons and incubator competitions. Through an active Writing Center, students participate in essay competitions and have published their writings and artwork in collaboration with Columbia University Student Press annually. The Hisar Young Philharmonic Orchestra, established in honor of the 25th anniversary of Hisar School, consists of professional musicians and Hisar students. Last but not least, many students conduct original research under the guidance of faculty and submit their work for publication and presentation at international conferences.
